ELIGIBILITY:

* Must be in business for at least 6 months before applying (December 1, 2023 or earlier)

* Must have a business-only bank account

* Funding can be requested to pay for equipment, services, and specialized software. Inventory, salaries, office

supplies, rent, utilities, and construction or building upgrade costs are not eligible.

* Must provide detailed cost of each proposed item or service to be funded, including tax and freight.

Use this SAMPLE application to gather the information you will need to complete the online application. The online application will not let you see all the questions at one time until you complete each section. Also, you can't save the online application to gather information and return to it later.

SECTION 6 – Use of Funds

Tribal Economic Diversity Funds are awarded to help northern NM tribal member-owned businesses make needed purchases to diversify, sustain or grow revenue, leverage other investments, and/or put systems in place that lead to growth and create job opportunities.

The funds are to be used to purchase services (examples: training, or legal services) or equipment that will increase revenues and/or add jobs.

General operating expenses such as rent, utilities, cell phone or internet service charges, office supplies, inventory (including materials used to create inventory), salaries, and monthly software subscription fees are NOT ELIGIBLE.

IMPORTANT: Unless otherwise discussed in advance, if awarded, funds are not released upfront, but as reimbursement upon receipt of paid invoices for awarded purchases.

NOTE: It is important to get good estimates of the proposed costs, as the award will be based on these estimates. Don't forget to include shipping costs and Gross Receipts Tax (GRT), if applicable. Purchases made before a fully executed agreement is in place will not be eligible for reimbursement.
